New travel restrictions are in place, supply lines are seeing strain again and the current administration is again releasing restrictions, mandates and curfews to reduce the spread of this virus that has shaken us all. THIS IS NOT A POLITICAL email and no matter what camp you sit in I am forced to look at how it affects our business and our staff. Please do not flood this email with your political opinions, trust me I am drowning in my own.

In light of the last couple weeks we have made a tough decision here at The Bistro in order to persevere through the long winter months, protect our staff and protect our patrons.

We have taken the following steps to ensure we are able to provide you with great food and drinks throughout the next couple months:

We have removed 25% of our tables, leaving only eight available for dine in customers. If possible please call ahead to reserve seating so you are not forced to wait and we can ensure you have a great dining experience start to finish.

We will be once again offering our full menu and a large to go menu for those who wish to dine at home and would prefer curbside service. Order at 207.793.9612 and call when you arrive, masked staff will bring your order to you or leave it on the outside pick up table. You may pay over the phone for your order.

Our Annual Thanksgiving Dinner which many have enjoyed WILL NOT take place. We WILL be offering a limited Holiday menu for you to pick up, offering traditional Thanksgiving fare and more for those who are dining at home and don't want to prepare full meals. Below are our To Go Thanksgiving menus for pick up between 10am and 3pm. We are also happy to provide a Dinner With The Works prepared for you, ready to reheat, or hot and ready to serve based on the number of guests you are having. We ask this be ordered 48 hours in advance.

Effective Monday our hours will be changing in reflection to current business and the repeated direction of Governor Mills and the media for people to not dine out or gather in groups. We will continue to offer a clean, sanitary and great dining experience but on a more limited basis. During those hours our Daily features, Full menu and expanded Family Style Menu will be available for pickup as well, either curbside or inside.

Our hours will be:

Wednesday, Thursday and Friday 3:30pm-8:30pm
Saturday 12pm-8:30pm

We have reduced staff to limit the exposure to patrons and vice versa. These are unprecedented times and decisions not made lightly or easily. Until this pandemic is under control and we are able to make mandate free decisions we have made the tough choices.
